In the absence of a secretary, Charlie Cook recorded these minutes.

The meeting was called to order by the President Charlie Cook.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved in a motion by Mill MacPherson and seconded by Jim Walker.

1. Charlie Cook introduced Ms. Mariann Russell, Client Relations Consultant from the Ministry of Health to the meeting. - 4. The Treasurer Joy Baby reported a bank balance of \$2,381.84, one GIC for \$1,000.00 and one GIC for \$2,000.00.
- 5. The Annual General Meeting
 - 1. The President will prepare an agenda and have copies of the last A.G.M. ready for distribution.
 - 2. The following motions will be included in the agenda:
 - To approve a \$300.00 donation to Wentworth Lodge to purchase a suction pump;
 - b. to approve a \$100.00 donation to the Chedoke-McMaster Growth Fund.
