- Nominating Committee Action: Nora will send Hank the guidelines for the Chair of the Nominating Committee (done). Volunteers from Council are invited to be on the Committee.
- Barry Diacon volunteered to join the **Pension & Benefits Committee**.
- Betty Ann Levy and Jan Nicholson volunteered to join the Volunteering Committee.
- Fundraising MURA Cards: Mary Gauld volunteered to manage this during social events.
- Jan Nicholson agreed to continue on the MIRA Community Partner Network.

4.3 2022-23 projects/issues

Constitution: We need to discuss whether to change the constitution so as to include virtual or hybrid meetings. This would also be a good opportunity to:

- move the current two bylaws into the constitution,
- change the dates for approval of standing committee chairs and members, and
- possibly change the definition of a retiree.

Action: Brian and Nora will locate the proposed constitutional changes that were drafted in January – February 2020 (done).

- Constitutional amendments have to be passed no later than March in order to meet the 60-day deadline before the AGM.
- Volunteers who are interested in working on this over the next six months are invited to contact Brian or Susan.

Definition of a retiree: MURA needs to re-engage with the university about who is considered a retiree, by the university and by MURA. People who retire without benefits and a pension are not considered retirees by the university, but are considered retirees for MURA's purposes. It could be that the University is waiting for MURA to propose a definition of retiree for the purpose of transferring the information on the identity of these people to MURA. **Action**: Barry will get a copy of Unifor 5555's definition of a retiree.

4.4 Council meeting in fall term: Zoom (or other virtual meeting technology), in person or hybrid?

Action: Jan will look into the technology necessary for hybrid meetings. Whatever room we get, we have to make sure it's well ventilated.
