Possible switch from Wild Apricot to McMaster Media Services for web hosting

• Jan reported that she can get the transfer of the website for free. The maintenance fees are \$1,200 per year. No definitive answer on whether we might get it for less down the road.

- Wild Apricot fees are currently USD \$979.20 / 2 years = CAD \$1,383.34, or \$691.67 / yr. for a Personal account
- Starting April 27, 2024, they will go up to USD \$1,224.00 / 2 years, = CAD \$1,638 / yrs., or \$819 / yr. (at today's exchange rates)
- Council decided that owing to the comparative prices, and the work involved in switching, there is no advantage to switching web hosts at this time.
