

New Retiree – Benefit Reminders

When you retired from McMaster, you would have met with someone in Human Resources and were provided with a lot of information at that time. Now that you are hopefully settling into your new routine we thought a couple of reminders regarding your benefits might be beneficial!

Eligible retirees are able to continue with Retiree Benefits once they retire. The Retiree Benefit Plan often has a few differences from your active employee plan. It's **important** to be aware of any coverage changes.

Changes could include things such as:

- Annual Maximums this is the amount you can claim per benefit in a benefit year
- ➤ Percentage Reimbursed This is the percentage of the claim which is eligible to be reimbursed. Coverage can vary.
- ➤ Lifetime Maximums this usually applies to things such as Travel and Orthodontics

Extended Health Care includes items such as:

✓ Prescriptions ✓ Medical items ✓ Paramedical coverage ✓ Vision Care ✓ Out of Province

Dental Coverage includes items such as:

✓ Basic Procedures – Cleaning/Scaling ✓ Major Coverage – Crowns, Bridges etc. ✓ Orthodontics

How to Check Your Coverage:

- o **Call Sun Life Directly!** Sun Life can provide you with the most up to date information about your coverage. Including your balance if you have already used Services with maximums.

- Check your Benefit Booklet! Benefit Booklets are posted on the Working at McMaster website and are currently in the process of being updated.
- Get a Pre-Determination If you are getting a service done over \$500 Sun Life requests you send in a predetermination to ensure coverage. Often the service provider can send this in on your behalf prior to you receiving services.

- o If you have a spouse covered under your benefits, your health and dental benefit coverage can continue for your surviving spouse in the event of your death.
- o If you have Retiree Life Insurance Policy, you can update your beneficiary at any time
